Recruitment Criteria

This position is suitable for people who:

- Are enthusiastic with excellent communication skills
- Enjoy the outdoors and have an appreciation for / some knowledge of nature and wildlife
- Enjoy speaking to small groups of people or leading tours of all ages (children, adults, teens)
- Enjoy challenging themselves and continuously learning
- Are environmentally responsible
- Can commit to dedicating two to four shifts per month for at least two years (a minimum of 75 hrs./ year) on the Zoo site.
- Are flexible, willing to assist where necessary
- Are able to work well independently and as part of a team

This position includes walking (1 to 2 hours) and standing (up to 3 hours). Toronto Zoo is wheelchair accessible and welcomes applicants who use assistive devices such as wheelchairs, scooters etc
